## **Historical Information**

- President Thomas Woodrow Wilson (1856-1924) had a stroke in 1919 and that is why the US did not get into the league of Nations; the stroke disrupted his campaign and his wife, Edith, was the only one allowed to see him and speak for him. In fact, she was believed to have made many important decisions while he convalesced, but never fully recovered.
- He did not have the opportunity to make clear that the US should join the league of Nations,... which was eventually created, but without the participation of the United States. The US would not join a multinational league until after an even larger and more destructive world war forced the League to be reinvented as the United Nations.
- Vladimir Ilyich Lenin (1870-1924) had 3 sequential strokes from May 22, 1923 on and his last stroke left him communication impaired. He wanted Trotsky to be his successor but Stalin usurped power and won...

## Strokes in Greece

- Average age in Greece around 70, similar with rest of Europe
- Frequency is similar with other Balkan and Mediterranean countries, like Spain, Portugal and Italy
- Risk factors for Greek population are hypertension, stress and smoking
- Ischemic strokes are overwhelmingly more common than hemorrhagic strokes
- Outcome depends on several factors, such as previous stroke, age, smoking and severity at onset

# Information and Stroke Groups

Research has shown benefits of group treatment over individual therapy as:

- Facilitates the transfer of functional communication
- skills to outside situations by improving turn-taking,
- conversation initiation, and increasing other communicative functions, as well as more natural activities and a variety of partners.
- May increase the participation in community life, increase psychosocial functioning and adjustment to life.
  - A cost effective model for the participants. (Elman, 1999)





## Don't trust everything you read

### RELIABILITY TEST

An effort to reproduce 100 psychology findings found that only 39 held up.\* But some of the 61 non-replications reported similar findings to those of their original papers.

### Did replicate match original's results?

### Replicator's opinion: How closely did findings resemble the original study:

- Virtually identical
- Moderately similar
- Extremely similar Very similar Somewhat similar Slightly similar
- \* based on criteria set at the start of each study



## Information exchange and online Stroke Groups

- People with stroke can benefit from the use of online forums where they can find advice and social support (De Simoni *et al.* 2016).
- Chronic patients, including patients with stroke, use online social support groups, which some times they even prefer from live groups (Owen *et al.* 2010)
- Online social support groups can also benefit the care givers of stroke patients, who can turn to these groups for information about the specific disorder, for emotional support and assistance to adapt to their role (Pierce *et al.*, 2002).
- With web-based supportive intervention, care givers were found to be more informed about disorders and could more effectively communicate with their stroke patients as well as their family (Pierce *et al.*, 2002).

## **European perspective**
